We have reserved room blocks at the venue. Rushpool Hall also offers limited on-site accommodation, so early booking is suggested.

Choose from 18 elegantly appointed en-suite bedrooms of varying sizes. Each booking includes breakfast for two, served from 08:00 to 10:00. Check-in is available from 15:00, and check-out is by 10:30, with an extended time of 11:00 for the couple. You are welcome to bring a blow-up bed and sleeping bag for an additional child or adult at no extra charge. Breakfast for extra guests is available at £10 per person; please request this when booking.

- 4 x Small Doubles – £135 (Rooms 204, 213, 218, 220)
- 9 x Standard Doubles – £155 (Rooms 201, 209, 211, 212, 214, 215, 216, 217, 219)
- 2 x Deluxe Doubles – £175 (Rooms 205, 207)
- 2 x Suites- £195.00 (Room 208, Room 210)

**Please note, Rooms 201–208** are located on the **1st floor** (one flight of stairs), while **Rooms 209–220** are on the **2nd floor** (two flights of stairs). As Rushpool Hall is a listed building, it **does not feature a lift**.

### **Additional Sleeping Accommodations:**

Rooms 201, 205, 207, 209: Accommodate up to two inflatable mattresses.

Room 208: Includes the option of two inflatable mattresses plus a sofa bed.

Room 210: Suitable for three inflatable mattresses.

Rooms 206, 211, 215, 216, 219: Permit one inflatable mattress.

Select rooms, namely 201, 208, 213, and 216, feature walk-in showers. Just to let you know, while cots are not provided, guests are welcome to bring their own.

### **Event Itinerary – Travel and Planning Information:**

Guests are invited to arrive two hours before the reception, coinciding with the bar's opening for refreshments.

### **Kindly Note:**

Changing or storage facilities are unavailable before the ceremony; thus, guests are encouraged to arrive suitably attired. Guest check-in commences at 15:00, post-ceremony.

### **Essential Guest Information:**

Check-in is available from 15:00, with exceptions for early check-in rooms.


Check-out is required by 10:30.

Please be aware that there is no elevator on the premises.

The venue operates on a cashless basis.

### **Comfort Provisions:**

Reserved quiet seating near exits for elderly guests. Children's activity table at the reception. Both venues have step-free access—please share any needs so we can assist.
